REGULAR BOARD MEETING & PUBLIC HEARING
JUNE 13, 2025**

A. CALL TO ORDER

The Regular Board Meeting of the Everlands Community Development District (the “District”) was called to order at 10:07 a.m. at 312 South Harbor City Boulevard, Melbourne, Florida 32949.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Proof of publication was presented which showed that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in *Florida Today* on September 30, 2024, as legally required.

C. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

A quorum was established with the following Supervisors in attendance:

Haley Mall, Jared Shaver and Bojana Brown

Also in attendance were Frank Sakuma and Stephanie Brown of Special District Services, Inc.; Ken Ludwa of B.S.E. Consultants, Inc.; and General Counsel Ginger Wald of Billing, Cochran, Lyles, Mauro & Ramsey, P.A. (by phone).

D. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

No additions or deletions to the agenda were offered.

E. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

F. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. April 11, 2025, Regular Board Meeting

The April 11, 2025, Regular Board Meeting minutes were presented for Board approval. A **motion** was made by Mr. Shaver, seconded by Ms. Brown and passed unanimously approving the minutes as presented.

1. Proof of Publication

2. Receive Public Comment on Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Budget

Mr. Sakuma opened the public comment portion of the Public Hearing to receive comments on adopting the fiscal year 2025/2026 final budget. He notified those in attendance that he had not received any comments prior to the hearing. There being no comments, Mr. Sakuma closed the public comment portion of the Public Hearing.

3. Consider Resolution No. 2025-03 – Adopting Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Final Budget

Mr. Sakuma presented Resolution 2025-03, entitled:

THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATION RESOLUTION OF THE EVERLANDS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT RELATING TO THE ANNUAL APPROPRIATIONS AND ADOPTING THE BUDGET FOR THE FISCAL YEAR BEGINNING OCTOBER 1, 2025, AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2026; AUTHORIZING BUDGET AMENDMENTS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE EVERLANDS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT ADOPTING AN ANNUAL REPORT OF GOALS, OBJECTIVES, AND PERFORMANCE MEASURES AND STANDARDS; PROVIDING A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the Everlands Community Development District (the “District”) is a local unit of special-purpose government organized and existing under and pursuant to Chapters 189 and 190, Florida Statutes, as amended; and

WHEREAS, effective July 1, 2024, the Florida Legislature adopted House Bill 7013, codified as Chapter 2024-136, Laws of Florida, and creating Section 189.0694, Florida Statutes; and

WHEREAS, the District adopted Resolution 2024-05 on August 9, 2024, establishing goals and objectives for the District and creating performance measures and standards to evaluate the District’s achievement of those goals and objectives; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 189.0694, Florida Statutes, the District must adopt and publish on its website an annual report prior to December 1st of each year, describing the goals and objectives achieved by the district, as well as the performance measures and standards used by the district to make this determination, and any goals or objectives the district failed to achieve.

WHEREAS, the District Manager has the annual report of the District’s goals, objectives, and performance measures and standards attached hereto and made a part hereof as **Exhibit A** (the “Annual Report”) and presented the Annual Report to the Board of the District; and

WHEREAS, the District’s Board of Supervisors (“Board”) finds that it is in the best interests of the District to adopt by resolution the attached annual report of the goals, objectives and performance measures and standards.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE EVERLANDS COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, THAT:

SECTION 1. The recitals so stated are true and correct and by this reference are incorporated into and form a material part of this Resolution.

SECTION 2. The District Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the Annual Report regarding the District’s success or failure in achieving the adopted goals and objectives and directs the District Manager to take all necessary actions to comply with Section 189.0694, Florida Statutes.

SECTION 3. If any provision of this Resolution is held to be illegal or invalid, the other provisions shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION 4. This Resolution shall become effective upon its passage and shall remain in effect unless rescinded or repealed.

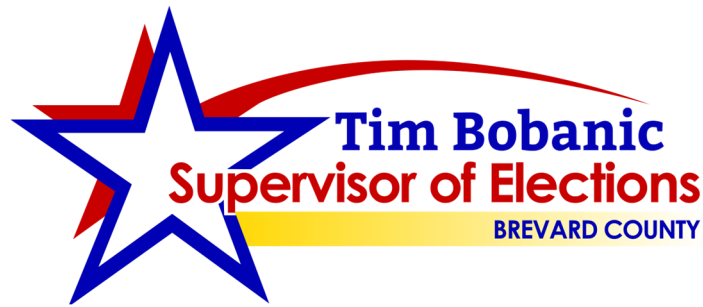
